




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Our Vision

CELEBRATING THE REALIZATION OF A PIVOTAL VISION: Access to Free Healthcare in West Treasure Valley

A historic moment took place on August 29, 2024, in which you played a key role: the dedication of the new Genesis Canyon County Clinic in Caldwell, Idaho. That day marked the beginning of local healthcare access for thousands of low-income uninsured people in West Treasure Valley.

The photo supplement (pages 4-7) in this year's annual report illustrates the facility made possible by caring supporters and friends of Genesis. My gratitude for your generosity and involvement is limitless!

Now, our key area of focus is to recruit needed volunteers and enlist new donors. Why is it necessary? The population of West Treasure Valley ineligible for Medicaid is estimated at some 23,000. They face hard decisions between medical insurance or basic necessities like healthcare, food, and housing. Genesis is the safety net that helps meet such needs.

To that end, we're building up our team of volunteers and donors so we can fully operate all four programs in Canyon County: medical, dental, mental health, and community health. When the full complement of volunteers and financial supporters is in place, we expect to serve 2,000 people at the Caldwell facility annually. *You* are the key to unlocking their access to healthcare.

Our community health workers are visiting communities to assess needs and refer low-income uninsured people to Genesis and/or other partner agencies. In God's timing, we project that, within five years, the two facilities in Garden City and Caldwell will care for approximately 3,500 people and provide 13,000 healthcare encounters annually.

Our patient Colby recently shared, "I make enough to live on, but not enough to get insurance. Genesis has made a huge difference in my life for the better." The team hears that sentiment from grateful patients every day.

I trust in God's provision through you to provide Genesis with the volunteers and funding needed to help thousands more struggling neighbors receive care for their untreated conditions. Please spread the word among people you know.


STATE-OF-THE-ART CLINIC

Patient Story

Tammy is a mother of four. Abuse had made divorce necessary. Without medical insurance coverage and not yet enrolled in Medicaid, she didn't know where to turn. That's when Tammy contacted Genesis.

CT scans revealed a large tumor on her left kidney, and she needed surgery. When Tammy received the diagnosis, she was frightened and in tears. Later in a letter to Genesis, Tammy expressed her thanks for the impact Genesis made on her life.



That night, two Genesis staff members came to the exam room and prayed with me.

They assured me I wasn't alone and that the team would support and see me through the entire process.

I've never had a doctor or nurse hug me before. They even stayed past closing time to comfort and reassure me until I left. I was so grateful!

Genesis referred me to one of the surgeons in its Volunteer Physician Network (VPN). He not only performed my surgery at his cost, but also rearranged his schedule so he could operate at once. I was so grateful he didn't put me on a waiting list.

I now have graduated from Genesis, and I'm forever grateful for my new and better life because of the medical care and support they gave. The Genesis team was a true blessing!



I've been serving with Genesis as a volunteer medical provider after having previously done so at another organization. At Genesis, I see firsthand the impact it makes on people.

For example, a patient who came to establish care needed several tests done. The lab results revealed he had out-of-control diabetes. He was overwhelmed and scared. He had never been diagnosed as a diabetic before, so I talked to him about things he could do to help his condition.

When he returned to see me three months later, his diabetes was nearly reversed. The patient had followed every bit of advice I had given to him, and now he's almost non-diabetic. Along with Genesis' emphasis on whole-person wellbeing, one of their mandates I appreciate most is having the time to educate patients as well as treat them.

Edna was apprehensive when she arrived for her first visit. In pain due to a mouthful of decayed teeth, Edna was afraid to smile. She also was embarrassed by her clothing that pointed to financial struggles.

To the dental team, however, Edna was a valued individual. Caring for her with kindness and concern for her wellbeing, the team reconstructed her front teeth and repaired all decayed teeth with fillings.

After several visits, Edna was pain-free, and her teeth were healthy. Her changed demeanor was remarkable. Smiling and confident, Edna thanked the team and said, "I feel so comfortable and welcome here!"

Edna is one of the hundreds of patients whose outcomes and transformation attest to Genesis' mission and impact.

STRATEGIC FOCUS 2025

NEED

More than 50,000 low-income uninsured neighbors fall outside Medicaid eligibility across the counties that make up West Treasure Valley: Ada, Adams, Boise, Canyon, Elmore, Gem, Owyhee, Payette, Valley, and Washington.

PLAN

To help address healthcare needs, over the next 12 months Genesis purposes to . . .

- 1. Increase the number of volunteers so both Garden City and Caldwell clinics can operate every day with additional hours and care for more neighbors in need.
- 2. Partner with more financial supporters (individuals, churches, businesses, grant makers).
- 3. Increase public awareness of Genesis' free whole-person healthcare services: medical, dental, mental health, and community health resources, so more underserved people can access the services they need.

DESIRED IMPACT

- 1. Uninsured low-income people throughout the entire Treasure Valley will have access to free whole-person healthcare, enabling them to improve their quality of life and that of their families.
- 2. Genesis will be an effective developer of future healthcare providers by enabling healthcare students to experience meaningful encounters with disadvantaged people.
- 3. Genesis will be a catalyst that motivates and positively involves Treasure Valley residents with helping their neighbors in need, thereby improving community life.
- 4. God's loving grace will be evident through Genesis' services, staff, and volunteers.

You are the key to unlocking access to transformative whole-person healthcare for underserved neighbors in need. As God directs, and with your participation as a volunteer and/or supporter, within five years Genesis will double the number of uninsured low-income patients it serves today.
