Job Summary

The contract Medical Provider delivers primary care services in a clinic setting, providing compassionate, high-quality medical care to adult patients. This role includes evaluation, diagnosis, treatment, and coordination of care while collaborating closely with the interdisciplinary clinic team.

Contract Terms

- This is a 1099 independent contractor position.
- Contractors are responsible for their own taxes and professional expenses unless otherwise specified.
- Malpractice coverage: Genesis provides medical malpractice coverage.
- Scheduling is flexible and based on mutually agreed-upon clinic needs.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Evaluate, diagnose, treat, and manage adult patients with a wide range of acute and chronic conditions.
- Provide medical consultations and develop appropriate treatment plans within the clinic's scope of practice.
- Collaborate with nurses, medical assistants, scribes, and other clinic staff to coordinate patient care.
- Document patient encounters accurately in the electronic health record (EHR).
- Communicate diagnoses, treatment plans, and follow-up instructions clearly and compassionately.

- Experience performing medical assessments and providing patient care in a clinical setting.
